



WATER PARK RULES

GOOD HYGIENE IS IMPORTANT FOR SAFE, CLEAN WATER

- Please shower yourself and your children before entering the water.
 - Please do not drink the swimming pool water.
- Diaper dependent guests must wear approved waterproof swim diapers in all pools and attractions.
- Changing diapers on or around the pool decks is not permitted, please change in restrooms.
 - Please wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after using the restroom.
 - Anyone who has experienced a stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past 2 weeks should not participate in any water activities.
- In compliance with Pennsylvania's minimum standards for swimming pool, no person with a communicable disease is allowed to use the swimming area. The following diseases are known to be transmittable through water: Shigellosis, Campylobacteriosis, Salmonellosis, Hepatitis A, Cryptosporidiosis, Giardiasis, and E. coli.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Children should not be left unattended!
 - No running.
- Life jackets are available to our weak and non-swimmers at no charge.
- Some attractions have specific height and health restrictions that are strictly enforced.
- * Please read all posted requirements and restrictions at the entrance of each attraction prior to waiting in line and participating.
- Non-Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices are prohibited.

WEATHER

- Inclement weather in the general vicinity of the waterpark may cause attractions or pools to close.
- Waterpark staff will not re-open until unsafe conditions completely move from our area.

PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED

- Swimsuits must be appropriate for our family environment.
- Proper shoes and attire must be worn when leaving the waterpark.
- Swimsuits with buttons, rivets, or snaps are not permitted on some attractions.
 - Denim shorts are not permitted on some attractions.
 - Shirts and shoes must be removed for some attractions.
 - Please visit the gift shop for all your swim wear needs.

LOCKERS

- All day locker rentals are available (limited quantity available).
- All lockers must be emptied by the closing time of the waterpark.

FOR YOUR SAFETY AND BENEFIT

- Our training of the waterpark lifeguard staff is continuous.
- Training drills may occur at any time in any of our attractions and may involve mannequins of simulated victims.
- Thank you for your understanding and support any questions should be directed to a facility supervisor.
